Paid \$7,115,977 in taxes

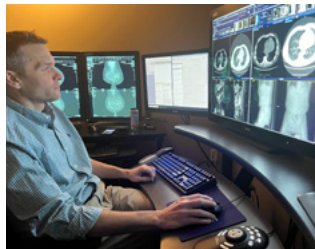
We are proud to be a leader in our region, and our dedication to ensuring fiscal responsibility extends both to our hospital and to our community.
